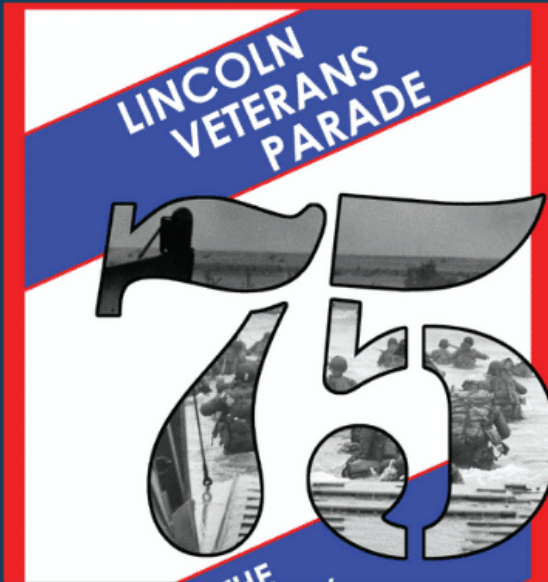

## USING PHOTOS AND PHOTOGRAPHY

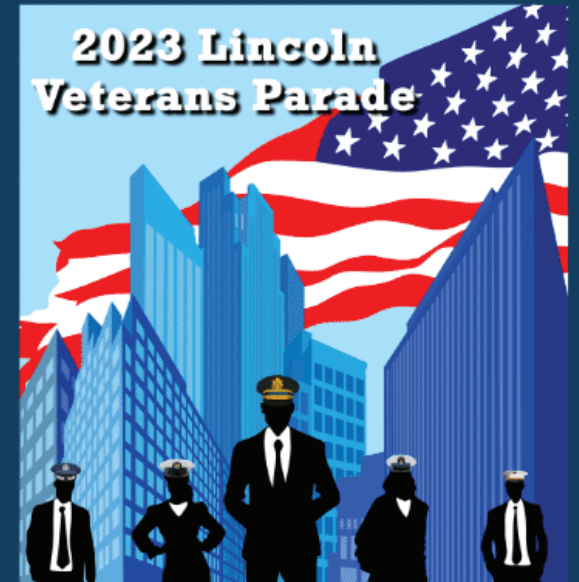
Explore your creativity in photography to create captivating and meaningful images for the audience. Ensure that your work is relevant and respectful to the theme of the parade while showcasing your unique style.

- Your final submitted art piece must be human generated (no AI). Inspiration can come from anywhere but we want to see your work.
- All photos and imagery used must have prior permission from the original artist, as it applies.
- Marketing prints will be in 4" x 6" 8.5" x 11" and 11" x 17" respectively. Please keep this in mind for when we add informational text.
- A low resolution image may be submitted via email or high resolution via Dropbox. You will be notified if a high resolution file is needed.

All submissions must have the following information.

- Name of the artist or artists.
- Contact information, including city and state.
- Brief bio of the artist or artists.
- Inspiration of the art piece.
- And any other information you find relevant.
